



TERMS & CONDITIONS

- All classes must be paid termly in advance. We will not accept weekly payments. No cash will be carried by Dance Dynamique staff.
- Term fees are non refundable. Fees must be paid for all students regardless of non attendance due to holidays/trips/other commitments.
- We only operate during school terms therefore refunds will not be given for classes missed due to holidays/trips/other non Dance Dynamique commitments.
- If a pupil is off for more than 4 weeks due to ill health/injury your place will be reserved and fees frozen until you return.
- New pupils will pay for their first class in cash (1 hour classes £4, ½ hour classes £2) the remainder of the term will be billed and is due the following week.
- Pupils must be dropped off and collected promptly. Dance Dynamique staff are only responsible for students during the set class time.
- Please be considerate when arriving and leaving the premises as we are in a residential area.
- Cars left in the car park at the owners risk
- Correct uniform must be worn every lesson:
 - Ballet / tap girls – pale blue leotard and skirt, pink ballet shoes, pink ballet socks, black canvas tap shoes.
 - Ballet / tap boys – white sleeveless leotard or white PE T-Shirt, navy dance or PE shorts, white ballet shoes, white ballet socks, black canvas tap shoes.
 - Street dance – black jazz pants / joggers/ leggings, black top or Dance Dynamique T-shirt, trainers or PE pumps.
- Hair must be appropriate for the lesson. For ballet classes girls hair must be in a classical bun with all hair off the face with either grips or a head band.
- NO jewellery must be worn at any time.
- Anyone not wearing appropriate clothing will be refused entry to the class due to health and safety.
- Dancers must be presented neatly every lesson.
- Dance Dynamique are not responsible for loss of belongings ie phones/money/ipod etc do not bring these to class.
- No chewing gum
- No food to be brought to class
- Water only in a sports bottle
- All pupils must have completed our Personal Details and Medical Form before commencing any classes.
- Physical contact may be necessary to assist training.
- If a particular pupil is disrupting the lesson they will be asked to sit out.
- Bad behaviour and bullying are not tolerated. Pupils will be given a formal warning



and if the problem persists they will be asked to leave the academy. Parents will be informed of all matters.

- Dancing promotes a healthy lifestyle. Pupils should expect hard work and physical exertion in a fun and friendly atmosphere.
- We expect all pupils to be courteous and polite to staff, each other and visitors. Staff must be addressed as Mrs, Miss or Mr
- When on trips/excursions all pupils must have prior written consent at least 7 days before the event.
- We expect all pupils to behave appropriately whether at class or off site at a competition or performance.
- Pupils will be placed in the appropriate class for their standard within our system. This may mean that pupils are moved classes depending on their progress.
- Pupils will be selected to take examinations at the discretion of the teacher. Exam groups are chosen on readiness for the syllabus not on age.
- All pupils must treat the building with care. Any vandalism must be paid for.
- When wearing the Dance Dynamique logo please remember you are representing the academy and we expect you to be a model pupil.
- We do not allow parents, friends or other family member to sit in and watch classes as this is a distraction to our dancers. Parents may watch the first lesson if your child is distressed. There will be open days every other term and presentation classes throughout the year. We do however strongly recommend parents watch all additional exam lessons to assist with practise at home.
- Once exam timetables are issued they CANNOT be changed. When provisional exam dates are released please contact us immediately if you have a serious problem. Examinations may take place on a week day. Children can be taken out of school for these.
- We are very safety conscious and all moves will be taught with great care and understanding of technique. All staff are qualified through the IDTA or similar dance body.
- If you are missing for 3 consecutive weeks your place will be given to someone else.
- A First Aid kit will be on site every week. All injuries must be reported to staff at the time.
- All staff at Dance Dynamique hold a current CRB check.

On signing the Personal Details and Medical Form you are accepting all of the above.

Any breach of this will jeopardise your place at Dance Dynamique.
